AMENDMENT NO. 1 OF 2024

It is hereby notified that amendments have been made to Parts 13 and 14 of the Supreme Court Practice Directions 2021. The amendments are summarised below:

- (1) amendments to paragraph 113 on Civil Appeals from the State Courts to the General Division; and
- (2) amendments to paragraph 121 on Preparation of records of appeal, written Cases, written submissions and core bundles.

To avoid doubt, despite the amendments, paragraphs 113(8)(a) and (b) and 121(5)(a) and (b) of the Supreme Court Practice Directions 2021 as in force immediately before 1 February 2024 continue to apply to and in relation to any appellant's core bundle of documents filed before that date.

Supreme Court Practice Directions 2021 (Amendment No. 1 of 2024)

Part 13: Civil Appeals before the General Division

113. Civil Appeals from the State Courts to the General Division

...

(8) The contents of the appellant's core bundle of documents must be arranged in the following separate volumes:

(a) **Volume 1A** – A table of contents listing the documents included in Volumes **1A** and **2B**, the certified copy of the written judgment or grounds of decision of the lower Court, and the extracted order of the lower Court.

(b) **Volume 1B** – All other documents referred to in Order 19, Rule 3 of the Rules of Court 2021 and a table of contents listing the documents included therein.

Part 14: Proceedings before the Appellate Division, the Court of Appeal, the Court of 3 Supreme Court Judges under the Legal Profession Act 1966 and appeals to the General Division under the Medical Registration Act 1997

121. Preparation of records of appeal, written Cases, written submissions and core bundles

...

Arrangement of the appellant's and respondent's core bundles of documents and the second core bundle

(5) The documents to be included in the appellant's and respondent's core bundles of documents and the second core bundle are stipulated in Order 19, Rule 3 of the Rules of Court 2021. The contents of the appellant's core bundle of documents must be arranged in the following separate volumes:

(a) **Volume I A** – A certified copy of the judgment or grounds of decision of the lower Court, the extracted order of the lower Court, and a contents page listing the documents included therein.

(b) **Volume H B** – All other documents referred to in Order 19, Rule 3 of the Rules of Court 2021 and a table of contents listing the documents included therein.
