It is hereby notified for general information that, with effect from 14th November 2014, the State Courts Practice Directions will be amended by deleting the existing Form 9I in Appendix B and replacing it with the following new Form 9I:

## New Form 9I of Appendix B

- 2 The new Form 9I (for use in recording consent judgments and terms of settlement) incorporates certain amendments which relate to
  - (a) the payment of Plaintiff's costs and disbursements in the usual consequential orders for Plaintiffs who are Specified Persons under the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Risk and Compensation) Act (Cap. 189);
  - (b) the determination by the Public Trustee of the Public Trustee fee, where usual consequential orders are recorded for Plaintiffs who are Specified Persons under the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Risk and Compensation) Act; and
  - (c) the inclusion of a "dependant" as an alternative to the "Plaintiff" in the usual consequential orders for Specified Persons under the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Risk and Compensation) Act, so as to enable the Court to make an order for the amount of the loss of dependency payable to a minor dependant to be paid via the Public Trustee before distributing it to the litigation representative of the minor dependant.
