MOBILE INFORMATION SERVICES ON HEARINGS IN THE SUPREME COURT

As part of Supreme Court's continuing efforts to provide better and faster service to our customers, with effect from 28 August 2001, handphone users who subscribe to Short Message Service ("SMS") will be able to access the following information using their handphone:

- (a) information on the Duty Judge;
- (b) information on the Duty Registrar; and
- (c) information on the case to be heard before a judge in the High Court or a matter to be heard in the Court of Appeal.
- To promote the use of our Supreme Court Mobile Information Services ("Supreme Court M-InfoSvcs"), besides the applicable SMS charges payable to the mobile phone operator, there is no additional charge for the service.
- If the service proves to be popular and effective, more information will be gradually added. With the implementation of Supreme Court M-InfoSvcs, lawyers should refrain from making telephone enquiries with the Registry for information that is available via SMS.
- Whilst every effort is made to ensure that the information is correct and up-todate, the Supreme Court shall not be liable for any damage or loss that may be caused to anyone as a result of any error or omission in the information, whether such error or omission arises from or is caused by negligence or otherwise, or as a result of reliance on or interpretation of any enquiry result.

 - ♦ Access the SMS facility on your handphone, and enter the following in bold according to your specific request:
 - a) To enquire about the Duty Judge

DJ ddmmyy

or

DJ

(This will be defaulted to today's date)

b) To enquire about Duty Registrar

DR AM

(This will default to today's date)

or

DR AM ddmmyy

(Specify AM or PM for the session)

c) To enquire about Case Judge

C Case No. Application No.

or

CASE Case No. Application No.

(Specify Case no. and/or Application no. without '/'. Eg. of Case no./Application no. – OS9992001)

d) To get help on the syntax
