AVAILABILITY OF COUNSEL FOR HEARINGS

From time to time, the court encounters situations where parties are unable to take hearing dates due to unavailability of counsel. The court will endeavour to accommodate counsel where possible. However, the Honourable the Chief Justice has directed that all counsel be reminded that where they are unable to accommodate their client's need for early resolution of the case, whether this is due to their busy court schedules or other commitments, they should discharge themselves from acting, so that the client may seek alternative representation.
