REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 3 OF 2016

RELOCATION OF ENTRANCE OF STATE COURTS BUILDING  
TO UPPER CROSS STREET  
WITH EFFECT FROM 3 DECEMBER 2016

Due to the construction of the new State Courts Towers, the entrance of the State Courts Building will be relocated from Havelock Square to Upper Cross Street on 3 December 2016.

2 In addition, the following changes will take place:

(a) ***Closure of vehicular access route to Havelock Square via Havelock Road and New Market Road from 2 December 2016, 10pm***

The vehicular access route to Havelock Square from Havelock Road and New Market Road will be closed from 2 December 2016, 10pm, due to the construction. As such, the passenger pick-up/drop-off point outside the Family Justice Courts Building will no longer be available.

(b) ***New passenger pick-up/drop-off points from 3 December 2016***

The new passenger pick-up/drop-off point for State Courts users and visitors will be along Upper Cross Street.

Family Justice Courts users and visitors can use the new passenger pick-up/drop-off point along New Market Road (entrance from Havelock Road).

(c) ***New temporary sheltered walkway along Upper Cross Street***

State Courts users and visitors walking to the State Courts Building from People's Park Centre and Chinatown MRT Station Exit D can use a new temporary sheltered walkway erected along Upper Cross Street to protect them from inclement weather.

(d) ***No change to pedestrian access route to the Family Justice Courts Building***

The pedestrian access route to Family Justice Courts Building from Chinatown MRT Station Exit D, People's Park Centre and Havelock Road remains unchanged.

3 Please refer to Appendix I for the new vehicular and pedestrian access routes to the entrance of the State Courts Building at Upper Cross Street.

4 The State Courts Towers are slated to be operational from 2020. In the meantime, a series of mitigation measures has been put in place by the contractor to control noise, dust and ensure public safety.
